Message from the president



Each year the Swiss and Italian Festa brings excitement and happiness to many individuals and groups in Hepburn Springs and Daylesford. It provides a showcase for the talents that exist in the area – the performers at the Festa; the hundreds of school children and the visitors from out of

town who come here to celebrate their Swiss and Italian heritage through singing and dancing.

Hepburn Springs has always proudly celebrated its Swiss and Italian pioneers and today there are sixth and seventh generations of these pioneers living here. Italian is taught as a second language in the primary and secondary schools, dry stone construction is evident across the Shire and producers today still celebrate the food and wine of these early settlers.

This year's Festa program encompasses all these aspects of our early history. There are heritage walks, bilingual storytelling, Boccia and bocce tournaments, an Italian cabaret, descendants' gatherings, family history research, an Italian operetta, open gardens, circus events and a multitude of Italian themed wine and food tastings. The highlights of the Festa are the grand parade down the main road of Hepburn and the family Festa concert in the mineral springs reserve, both on Saturday. The Festa closes with a lantern parade and fireworks finale on Sunday evening.

The Festa has been running since 1992, making it one of the longest running in central Victoria. It attracts strong support from government and business. The committee thanks the Hepburn Shire, the Victorian Department of Premier and Cabinet (Office of Multicultural Affairs and Citizenship) and the many businesses and individual supporters in the region. Without this support the Festa committee would not be able to present such a colourful and diverse program.

I encourage all visitors and locals to support the events listed in this program.

VILLA PARMA GARDENS

The Villa Parma garden, based on the Italian gardens of the seventeenth, eighteenth and nineteenth centuries is a series of interconnected 'rooms' offering different areas in which to seek solitude and clear one's mind, whilst wandering through controlled spaces dominated by shades of green.

When the original owner and founder of Villa Parma, Mr Fabrizzio Crippa constructed his imposing home in 1864, he also established an equally striking garden. Crippa masterfully interspersed the 20 acres of grapevines with fruits, vegetables and tobacco and a vine walk. Although the vines are no longer present, today the aromatic bay trees, lilacs, rose and herb gardens, topiaries, fig and olive trees continue to flourish, providing an enchanting reminder of its bygone glory.

DAYLESFORD HOUSE

Daylesford House was built in the 1870s by Charles Walton, a gold speculator who later became the town draper. It is a rambling Victorian house with an acre of gardens planted at about the same time as the Wombat Hill Botanic Gardens.

The garden has been redeveloped and extended over the past five years by its current owners Hal Swerisson and Candy Broad. It has magnificent established trees and terraced gardens with sweeping views of Wombat Hill to the south. Formal garden entertaining areas and verandahs with views of Daylesford to the west.



A rose garden and lavender hedges lie to the east. The garden features roses, camellias, rhododendrons, maples and a variety of hedges and exotic plants.


A spreading English oak, planted over 130 years ago, is a focal point of this large and varied garden on Sailors Hill.
